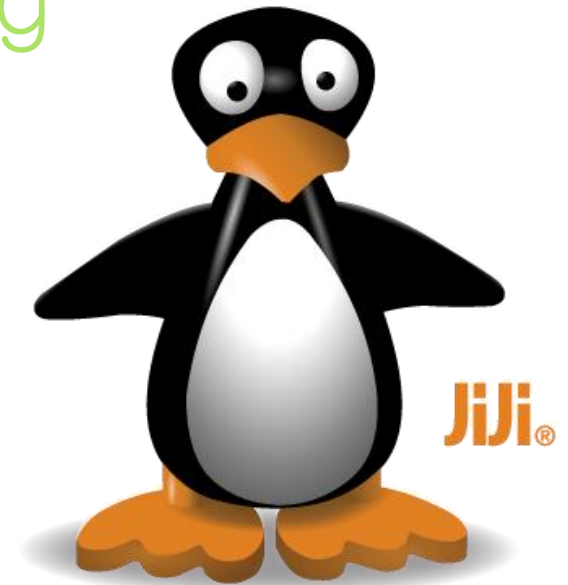

- ✧ Every scoop = 1 topping!

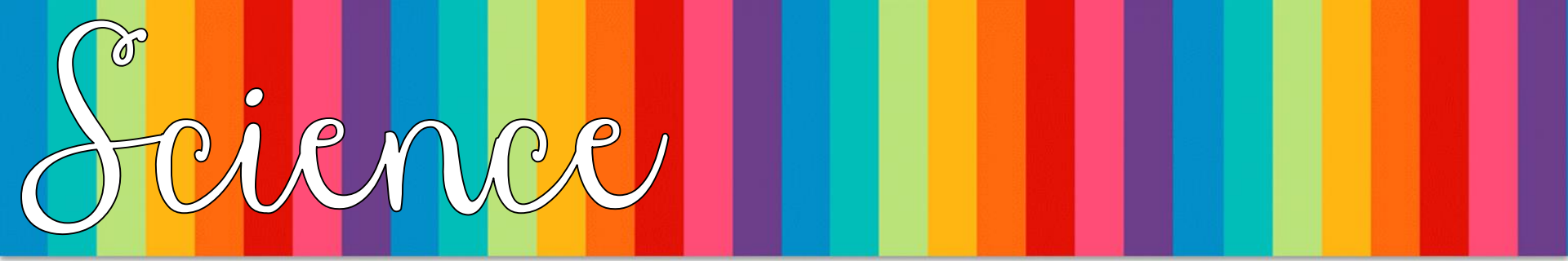
